

Sampling Machine Embroidery Techniques



Course content

Introduction to a range of more complex advanced machine embroidery techniques including bonding, layering, shadow work, trapunto and cut work. Final course project involves using a combination of techniques in an original design to create a small scale hanging or cushion panel.

Who is the course for?

Those with a basic working knowledge of machine embroidery. An ideal progression from "Machine Embroidery for Beginners".

Assessment method

Non accredited – no formal assessment

Entry requirements

Ability to work safely and have a good knowledge of basic machine embroidery techniques.

Progression to "Machine Embroidered Wall Hanging" course.
