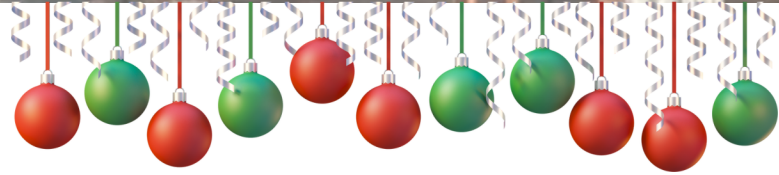
A big well done to the students who helped man the stalls and looked after the food and beverages. Your teamwork, responsibility, and hard work were fantastic!
